

Central Park Area Action Plan

Update March 2007

Area Action Plans are constantly being changed and updated throughout the production stage as they head towards the formal Submission to the Secretary of State (this is expected to be September 2007 when there is another formal consultation stage for the plan).

The Council has been processing the responses from the Preferred Option consultation held in November and December 2006. There have already been some significant decisions made as a result of consultation that will be reflected in the final Area Action Plan.

Consultation with the community and stakeholders will be ongoing over the coming months to look at ways of addressing some of the issues and suggestions that were made during the consultation period before the submission document is published for comment.

What happens next...

The Area Action Plan will be prepared alongside the emerging plans for Sharron Davies Centre (previously referred to as the Life Centre). The Council has agreed funding for the centre and aims to start work on the planning stage this year.

Discussions will take place over the coming months with community groups, businesses and other stakeholders to look at some of the issues raised in the consultation and how they can be addressed in preparation for submitting the Area Action Plan in September 2007.
