### Notice of Adoption of the Core Strategy

The Council has resolved to adopt the Core Strategy on 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2007. The Core Strategy sets out a vision, spatial strategy and overarching policies to guide development up to 2016. It forms part of the Local Development Framework for Plymouth City Council.

They are also available to view at libraries and housing offices across the City.

A Statement of Sustainability and Consultation is available as an annex to this notice and provides information regarding how the Sustainability Appraisal, consultation and the consideration of alternatives have been taken into account in the adopted Core Strategy.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Applications should be made within six weeks of the date of advertisement (24<sup>th</sup> April 2007).
