As a result of the Circular, all Council's now have a statutory duty to allocate sufficient land for Gypsy and Traveller accommodation needs. Between now and 2011, Plymouth needs to accommodate 40 permanent pitches and 15 transit pitches. This presentation will outline the sites that are currently under consideration and will explain the process for suggesting new sites.
