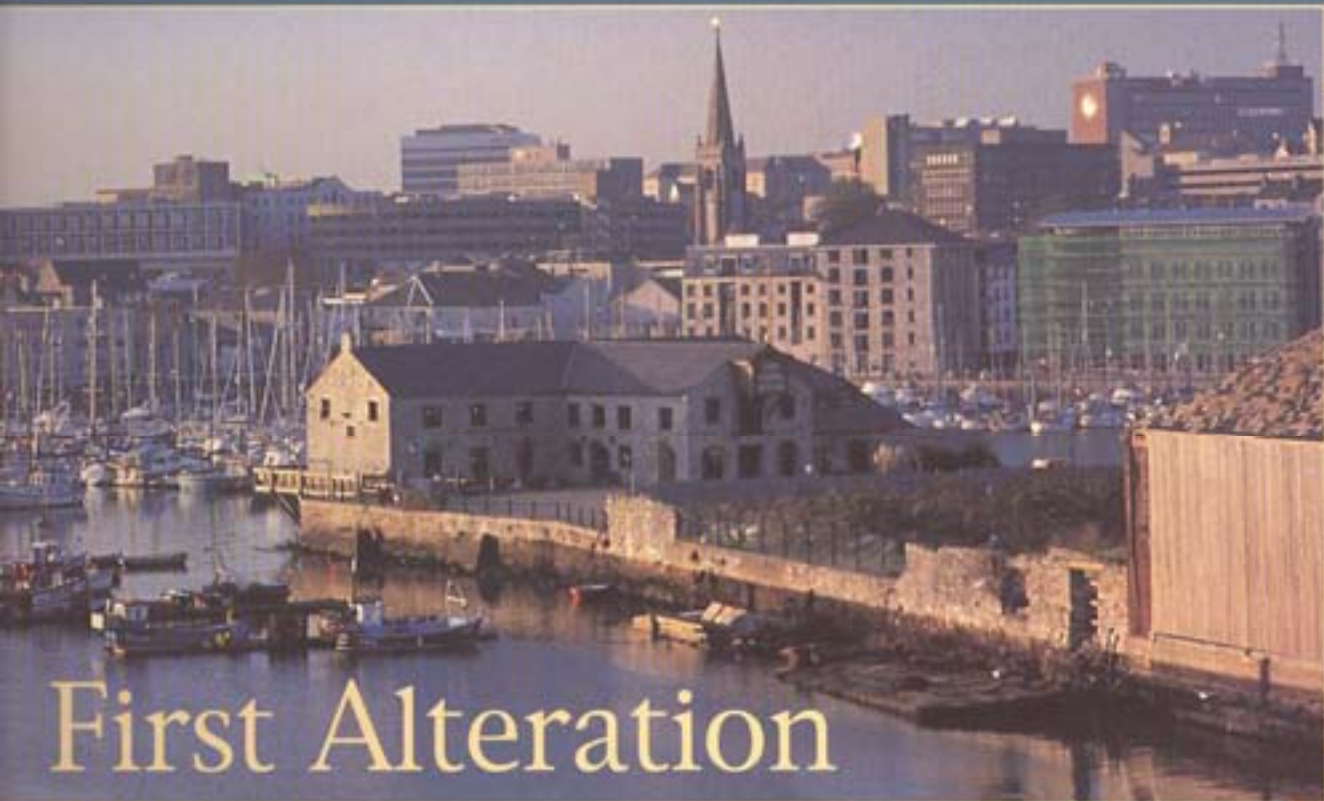

EXTRACT FROM THE PLANNING COMMITTEE MINUTES OF 13TH MAY 1996

279 With reference to minute 269, the Director of Development, the Head of Planning and Transportation Services and the City Solicitor submitted a joint report indicating that:-

- (i) the deposit period for the further third set of proposed modifications to the Local Plan First Alteration expired on 10th May, 1996.
- (ii) no objections or representations had been made in respect of the proposed further modifications;
- (iii) the proposals contained in the Local Plan First Alteration, as modified, conform generally to the Devon County Structure Plan;
- (iv) the Secretary of State had given no direction to the Council in respect of the proposals.

Resolved that, pursuant to Section 43(1) of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1990, the City of Plymouth Local Plan First Alteration, as modified, be adopted.

Planning Committee minute 279 was approved by the City Council at a meeting later on 13th May 1996.
