The City of Plymouth in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING  
PLACES)(AMENDMENT No. 2008.04 - TORRIDGE WAY) ORDER 2008

This shall have the effect of amending “The City of Plymouth (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places)(Consolidation) Order 2004” as follows:

- 1) That Article no: 32 be deleted and replaced with:

*Save as provided in **PART H** to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle which is not displaying in the relevant position a valid Parking Zone Permit displaying where applicable the correct zone identification letter(s) for the zone as defined in **PART K** to this Order and wait during the permitted hours as specified in the Eighth Schedule of this Order.*

- 2) The following items be added to the specified Schedules in the correct alphabetical Order:

## **LIST OF SCHEDULES**

- 1 No Waiting At Any Time
- 7 Disabled Driver Only Parking Bay Maximum Stay 2 Hours No Return Within 2 Hours

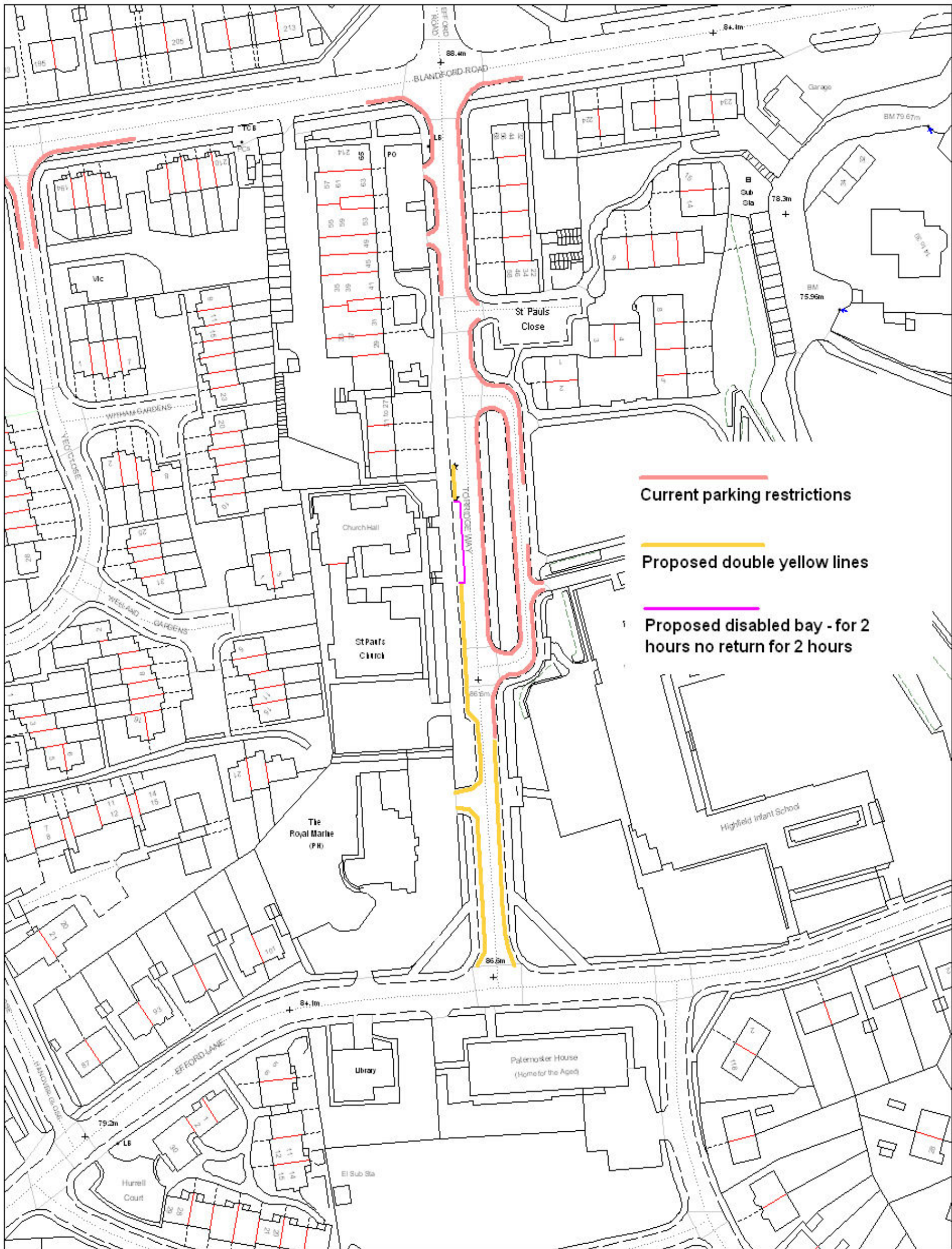
## **Schedule No**

### **1.1 No Waiting At Any Time**

- (i) Torridge Way, the east side from its junction with Severn Place for a distance of 57 metres in a northerly direction
  
- (ii) Torridge Way, the west side from a point 117 metres north of its junction with Efford Lane for a distance of 8 metres in a northerly direction
  
- (iii) Torridge Way, the west side from its junction with Efford Lane for a distance of 97 metres in a northerly direction
