### **School Library Association Primary School Classification Scheme**

This interactive pack contains everything you need to classify non-fiction books and enable pupils to find Dewey subject numbers easily. It contains:

- A searchable CD-ROM which is easy for pupils to use
- Subject Index for Primary School Libraries
- A Practical Guide to the SLA Classification scheme
- A colourful Dewey wall poster

The Practical Guide provides details of Dewey Decimal Classification and how to use it for organising and arranging the school library.

Pupils can obtain help to find what they are looking for, by searching for the appropriate keyword in the comprehensive alphabetical Subject Index. Alternatively, if the school library has a computer, they can use SubjectSearch, the simple database on CD-ROM, to find the subject they are looking for. To help pupils whose spelling is not perfect, the CD-ROM will search for close matching words and can be set to automatically complete the search word being typed. Technical support for the CD-ROM is included in the price.

The Primary School Classification Scheme has been designed for use in primary and middle schools in the UK. Particular attention has been paid to cultural and linguistic diversity.
