In accordance with Regulation 24 (4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is given that Plymouth City Council formally adopted its Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) on 24 July 2006 at Full Council.

An independent Inspector was appointed by the Secretary of State to examine the 'Soundness' of the Submitted SCI. The Inspector reported back to the Council on 5 July setting out binding changes to be made to the submitted SCI.
