

# BEACON PARK AND PENNYCROSS

## SUMMARY OF RESPONSES

This is a summary of some of the key issues emerging from the consultation process. Full copies of the representations can be viewed at the following web site:

One representation was received from someone who used to live within the neighbourhood and has relatives who still reside in the neighbourhood.

### Shopping

The respondent made no reference to shopping facilities within the neighbourhood

### Local issues

The respondent's comments related primarily to the Civil Service Sports Club site and the loss of the facilities which it used to offer local residents. The respondent considers the new housing developments in the neighbourhood to be characterless and not in keeping with the character of the area. Other comments related to the loss of Plymouth Argyle Football Club which the respondent feels would result in the breakdown of a community, and result in a negative effect for the city and its economy.

### Important Greenspaces

The respondent refers to the Civil Service Sports Club, identified on the consultation pamphlet as BP01. The respondent would like to see the site developed for sports facilities, namely football pitches and indoor sports.

### Potential Development Sites

The respondent would support the redevelopment of the Civil Service Sports Club site for the creation of new sports facilities.
