

Ebrington Street Conservation Area



Public consultation 19th November-31st December 2007

Plymouth City Council is considering the designation of a new Conservation Area based on Ebrington Street. A draft boundary, appraisal and management plan has been prepared. A 6 week consultation period will start on the 19th November until the 31st December as the City Council wants to know what the public think of these proposals.

There will be an **exhibition** outlining the main proposals in the porch of Holy Cross Church, Beaumont Road, from **19th – 30th November 2007 (9.30am – 4.30pm weekdays, with extended hours on the 27th and 29th November until 7pm)**. This will be manned on Tuesday 27th November between 2pm - 7pm when staff will be happy to discuss the proposals with you.

If you are unable to attend the exhibition, throughout the consultation period officers will be available during normal working hours at the Civic Centre to discuss the proposals (see the contact details below).
