If you have more garden waste than you can fit into the two bags provided, you can either compost it at home or take it to your local Household Waste Recycling Centre.

Home composting offer

Plymouth City Council, in partnership with Original Organics can offer Plymouth residents a choice of compost bins from only £12.50. You can collect your compost bin(s) from Woodvale or Fordbrook Nurseries using a voucher system, or have a delivery to your door for £4.50 a bin.

Your new garden waste collection



Garden waste information

- Collected on the same day as your recycling
- Collected from the same location as your recycling
- Garden waste can only be put out in the bags supplied (Maximum two bags per household)
- All bags must be put out for collection by 6.30am on your collection day
- Do not overfill your bags (25kg maximum)
- Extra garden waste can be taken to your local household recycling centre
- If you have not received your two re-useable garden waste bags please ring us on 668000.

Important

If you do not wish to use your garden waste bags please leave them out on your first scheduled collection day. We will remove them but remember that garden waste must not be put in brown bins or black refuse bags while the scheme is operating in your area.
