# Nine Tests of Soundness

Soundness may be considered in this context within its ordinary meaning of "showing good judgement" and "able to be trusted" and within the context of fulfilling the expectations of legislation.

**On the enclosed form please specify on which of the following tests of soundness you consider the Central Park Area Action Plan to fail:**

1. It has not been prepared in accordance with Plymouth City Council's Local Development Scheme (LDS)
2. It has not been prepared in compliance with the Statement of Community Involvement.
3. The plan and its policies have not been subject to a sustainability appraisal.
4.
  - a. It is not a spatial plan, or it has not properly had regard to any other relevant plans, policies and strategies relating to the area or to adjoining areas.
  - b. It is inconsistent with national policy.
  - c. It is not in general conformity with the regional spatial strategy.
5. It does not have regard to Plymouth City Council's community strategy.
6. The strategies/ policies/ allocations in the plan are not coherent and consistent within and between Development Plan Documents (DPDs) prepared by the authority and by neighbouring authorities, where cross boundary issues are relevant.
7. The strategies/policies/allocations fail to represent the most appropriate in all the circumstances, having considered the relevant alternatives, and they are not founded on a robust and credible evidence base.
8. There are no clear mechanisms for implementation and monitoring.
9. The plan is not reasonably flexible to enable it to deal with changing circumstances
