Outreach and home visits

We can support you to access activities at the children's centre and in the local area, depending on your family's needs. A parenting support worker can visit you if you would like some extra support and information, and together, a plan of support will be identified which can continue for up to 12 weeks. There will be regular reviews to ensure that the service is meeting your needs appropriately.

Areas we can help with

Parenting support including:

- managing behaviour
- child development
- home safety
- play
- healthy eating

Confidentiality

The support worker will not discuss anything about you or your family with other agencies, or local people, unless you have agreed to this. The exception is where a child or anyone else is at risk.

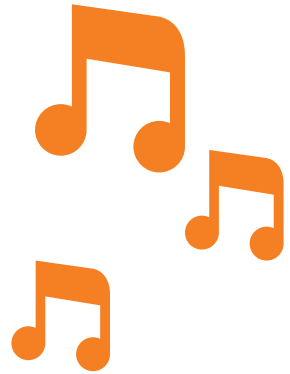


Children the best start in life
