### Events

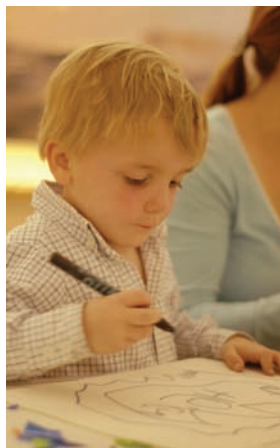
