# What grant aid is available?

## Travel and Accommodation

Applications are welcome from individuals or sports clubs who compete at County, Regional, National or International competitions/events. Awards are made depending upon distance, mode of transport and whether it is an individual or team application.

A map of the United Kingdom has been drawn into zones to simplify the process and outlines the amount of support you will receive when travelling to those areas. Accommodation is also considered under this grant.

## Sporting Qualifications / Awards

Applications are welcome from individuals who have attained a sporting qualification/award, or from sports clubs who intend to organise a sporting qualification or who have paid for club members to attend. These could include coaching courses, officiating courses, workshops, seminars or training courses as long as they are nationally recognised by a National Governing Body or other sporting body, such as Sports Coach UK, Sport England or Sports Leaders UK.

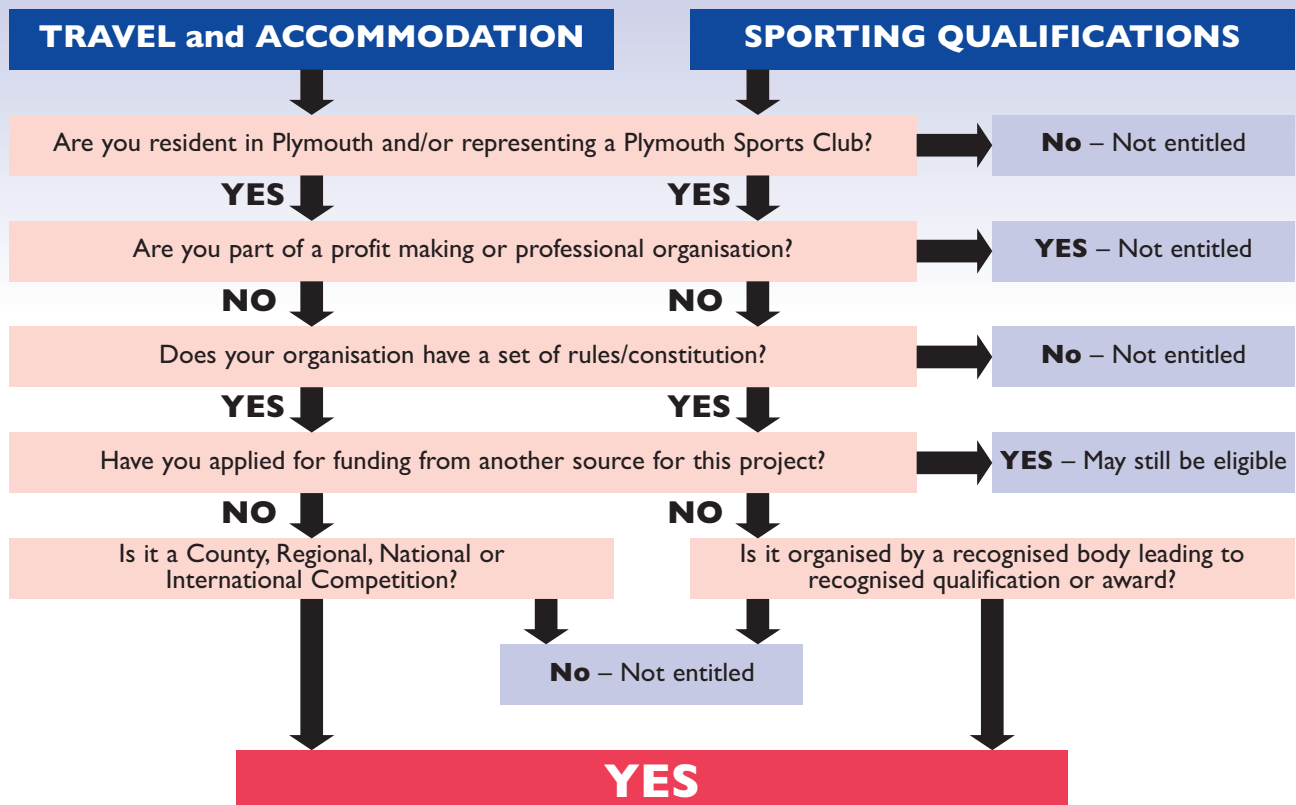
## How much support can I expect to receive?

The scheme has been designed to provide assistance towards and is not able to fund activities in their entirety. This way we can assist as many different applicants, from as many different sports as possible.

## Who will consider the applications?

All grant applications will be considered by the grants committee which includes representatives from the Plymouth Sports Forum. Meetings will take place in June, September, December and March of each year.
