The City of Plymouth in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH (TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS) (AMENDMENT No. 2010.1090498 – FORD HILL AREA) ORDER 2010

This shall have the effect of amending “The City of Plymouth (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2004” as follows:

- 1) That the following be added to Article 123 (Prohibited Turns) in the correct numerical sequence:

PART 4 **No Right Turn except for cycles** from any road specified to any road specified in Part 4 of the Two Hundred and Third Schedule to this Order;

PART 5 **No Left Turn except for cycles** from any road specified to any road specified in Part 5 of the Two Hundred and Third Schedule to this Order;

- 2) The following items be added to the specified Schedules in the correct alphabetical Order:

LIST OF SCHEDULES

203 Prohibition of Turns

203.4 No Right Turn

- (i) From Milehouse Road to Ford Hill

203.5 No Left Turn

- (i) From Ford Hill to Milehouse Road

Relevant Plan

Ford Hill/Milehouse Road – prohibition of left turn (except for cycles) from Ford Hill to Milehouse Road and prohibition of right turn (except for cycles) from Milehouse Road to Ford Hill as shown below
