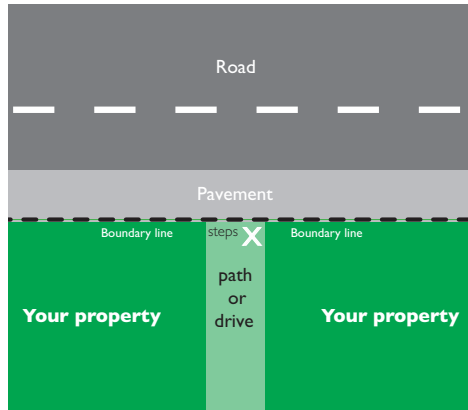


## PLACING YOUR RECYCLING ITEMS FOR COLLECTION

Please ensure that your rubbish and recycling are placed at the boundary of your property no earlier than 6.30pm the night before your collection, or no later than 6.30am on the day of collection. Placing the wrong items in your green recycling container may mean we cannot use those items that you have collected, or may also be a health risk to our workers.

## HOW TO RECYCLE YOUR HOUSEHOLD WASTE




 recycle  
for Plymouth


**Please put all these items loose into your green recycling container, NOT in bags**


 **Newspapers and magazines**  
plus items such as junk mail, printer paper and envelopes (including those with plastic windows)




 **Cardboard**  
Including packaging such as cereal boxes and greetings cards




 **Directories and catalogues**  
Telephone directories, mail order books and yellow pages


 **Plastics**  
Plastic bottles (please rinse out with tops removed and separated in your container), clean yoghurt pots and margarine tubs




 **NO** film, crisp packets, plastic bags, cellophane wrapping or expanded polystyrene

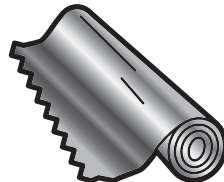


 **Food and drink cans**  
Must be rinsed clean

 **Aerosols**  
Empty cans (with tops removed and separated in your container)



 **Aluminium foil**  
Such as takeaway containers (please rinse out)



**Please also recycle glass and textiles at your nearest recycling bank and plastic bags at most supermarkets**

Recycling banks are located at a number of sites in and around Plymouth, such as supermarkets, DIY stores, car parks and clubs.

**Chelson Meadow and Weston Mill Recycling Centres**

These centres have a wide range of recycling banks and facilities for bulky items such as fridges, cookers, furniture, cooking and engine oils, soils and hardcore or wood. If you are unable to take large items to the centre, a bulky waste collection service is available.
