An Introduction to the Common Assessment Framework (CAF)

This short half day training course offers a comprehensive overview of the CAF as part of Integrated Working. It is aimed at anyone working with children, young people and their families and raises awareness of the common assessment framework and how it impacts on the work of practitioners. Practitioners should ideally attend this course prior to attending CAF for Practitioners.

CAF for Practitioners

This is a full days training course for anyone who has to complete CAF assessments as part of their day to day work with children, young people and their families. It looks at the potential impact of the CAF, deciding when a CAF would be useful, skills for completing the assessment and offers a brief look at the role of the lead professional. Practitioners should ideally attend this course prior to attending The Role of the Lead Professional.

The Role of the Lead Professional

This short half day training course looks at the Role of the Lead Professional and explores some of the issues, the benefits, concerns and uncertainties of carrying out this role. It is aimed at any practitioner who will be acting as lead professional.

An Introduction to Information Sharing

This short half day training course offers an overview to the sharing of information in the workplace and should be attended by anyone working with children, young people and their families. Practitioners should ideally attend this course prior to attending Information Sharing in Practice.

Information Sharing In Practice

This full days training course looks at the importance of information sharing as part of preventative services. It explores issues around consent, barriers to sharing, confidentiality and looks at the golden rules for successful sharing of information.
