### Inter-agency, Multi-Agency PSCB

**Inter-Agency Introduction to  
Child Protection: The  
Foundation Gateway course:  
“Understanding Child  
Protection” For groups 3 and  
above (WT2010) (equivalent to  
health Level 3)**

All front-line-staff: Youth workers; teachers; mentors; nursery staff; social workers; doctors; nurses; health visitors; CAMHS; Connexions; Volunteer workers; Police; Probation; child minders; sports coaches; tutors; adult workers in mental health; drug misuse services etc

### Refresher Course

For anyone needing a top-up after 2-3 years and has received the Foundation Training or similar (e.g. Schools designated person).

### Inter-agency Advanced Courses

For all designated, named people and their deputies, and practitioners and their managers who need to deepen their knowledge of inter-agency working having attended the Foundation Course.

### Specialist Courses

For those involved in assessment and intervention in cases of Hidden Harm, Domestic Abuse, Child Sexual abuse and Exploration, Neglect and Emotional abuse, Internet based abused and cyber-bullying, or requiring understanding of the value of supervision for child protection
