SUMMARY OF RESPONSES

This is a summary of some of the key issues emerging from the consultation process. Fuller versions of the representations can be viewed below.

Three representations were received, two from residents and one from a residents with school connection. The majority of who thought that the summary of the neighbourhood was a reasonable reflection of the situation.

Shopping

The shopping facilities were considered to be adequate and well served.

Local Issues

The need for more youth facilities was identified as being of the highest importance, along with public transport and traffic issues. A need for affordable housing was also recognised.

Greenspaces

A number of greenspaces have been identified. WI03 is a community open space and team sports area and WI07 is a main pathway across the area close to the George and small children's play area. The area south of the George has been identified as greenspace and should be protected.

Potential Development Sites

No sites have been identified in Widewell.

Other Comments

There is a lack of community and youth facilities in the area.

All greenspaces in the area are protected from development
