

CONSENT FOR INTERMENT IN A REOPENED GRAVE

Cemeteries and Crematoria

Regulations re reopened graves:

The exclusive right of burial only is granted for all graves and these will be subject to the following conditions:

1. The whole of the grave surface will be turfed flat at ground level within a 6 month period (except for an area designated for a headstone and floral vases if required) and will be maintained to a lawn standard.
2. An area of 900mm x 900mm (3' x 3') at the head of the grave may be designated for a memorial and floral vases if required.
3. The type of memorials and vases approved for the above area are as follows:
 - a memorial made of quarried stone not exceeding 900mm (height) on a base not exceeding 900mm (width) x 900mm (depth) (3' x 3' x 3')
 - a memorial made of quarried stone not on a base, not exceeding 300mm (height) x 600mm (width) x 450mm (depth) (1' x 2' x 1'6")
 - vases to be of quarried stone not exceeding 300mm (height) x 225mm (width) (1' x 9")
 - a memorial tablet made of quarried stone not exceeding 450mm x 225mm (1'6" x 9")
 - the angle of an open book etc should be such that it does not overlap the base.
4. No other objects to be placed around or on the lawn section of the grave (once turfed)
