14/11/2018	Chaddlewood Primary School	Plympton Chaddlewood	This resident expresses an objection to schools across the city being used as polling stations due to concerns that elections compromise children's safety and place an additional financial burden on families. The resident suggests using churches or community centres instead.
15/11/2018	Mobile Unit at Chaucer Way	Honicknowle	This resident expresses an objection to schools across the city being used as polling stations. The resident suggests using other venues or mobile polling stations instead.
16/11/2018	Compton CofE Primary School	Compton	This resident proposes moving the polling station for district LB in Compton ward out of Compton CofE Primary School due to concerns that the school closure compromises the children's education and is disruptive for parents.
18/11/2018	Emmanuel CofE Church	Compton	This resident expresses an objection to schools across the city being used as polling stations and in particular Compton CofE primary school, due to the additional burden placed on families to find alternative childcare.
19/11/2018	Widewell Primary School	Southway	This resident expresses an objection to schools being used as polling stations, due to the disruption schools' closures cause to children, parents and employers. The resident suggests using other locations in the city such as town halls, libraries and function rooms.
19/11/2018	Widewell Primary School	Southway	This resident proposes moving the polling station for district FE in Southway ward out of Widewell Primary due to concern that the school's closure compromises the children's safety and education and places a burden on working parents. The resident suggests using community spaces instead.

			compromises the children's safety and education and places a burden on working parents. The resident suggests using a mobile polling station instead.
26/11/2018	Beechwood Primary School	Southway	This resident expresses an objection to schools being used as polling stations, due to the impact of elections on safeguarding children and the disruption caused to parents.
26/11/2018	Manadon Vale Primary	Eggbuckland	This resident proposes moving the polling station for district HA in Eggbuckland ward out of Manadon Vale Primary School due to concerns that the school closure compromises the education of children in the foundation stage.
27/11/2018	Mount Gould Methodist Church	Sutton and Mount Gould	This resident expresses concerns about the ward boundary between Efford and Lipson ward and Sutton and Mount Gould ward. Due to the design of the boundary, the resident has to vote at Mount Gould Methodist Church, which is further away than the polling station on Kensington Road, which services district PA in Efford and Lipson.
24/11/2018	N/A	N/A	This resident warns against the consequences any changes of polling stations may have for electors, and comments on the need to advertise changes to polling station effectively in order to avoid residents attending the wrong venue. The residents recommends good publicity in advance and a consistent message issued to all polling stations staff, in particular those where a change is recommended.
29/11/2018	Manadon Vale Primary	Eggbuckland	This resident proposes moving the polling station for district HA in Eggbuckland ward out of Manadon Vale Primary School due to concerns that the school closure compromises children's education and security. The residents suggests multiple alternative polling stations, including the Golden Hind Public House, the Church of the Ascension, the Plymouth Hockey Club or the Manadon Sports Development Centre.
