Date	Polling Station	Ward	Comment
14/12/2018	St Phillip's Church	Ham	The resident questions the arrangements in place for disabled access to St Phillip Church on Bridwell Road in district BA of Ham ward. Access to the Church is limited due to its location on a steep hill. There is a long flight of steps at the entrance of the church. This is mitigated by an electric lift, but the resident expresses concerns as to its functionality, especially in poor weather condition. The resident asks whether an alternative location could be found either at Weston Mill Primary School or at Oak Villa Sports Club.
03/12/2018	Manadon Vale Primary School	Eggbuckland	This resident proposes moving the polling station for district HA in Eggbuckland ward out of Manadon Vale Primary School due to concerns that the school closure compromises the education of children in the foundation year. The resident expresses concerns as to the safeguarding of children whilst members of the public are allowed to access the site. The resident suggests postal voting should be encouraged.
03/12/2018	Manadon Vale Primary School	Eggbuckland	This resident proposes moving the polling station for district HA in Eggbuckland ward out of Manadon Vale Primary School due to concerns that the school closure compromises the children's attendance. The resident expresses concerns as to the safeguarding of children whilst members of the public are allowed to access the site.
05/12/2018	Redeemer Church, previously known as St Barnabas	Stoke	The resident asks us to check the suitability of the access ramp to the church.
06/12/2018	Derriford United Reformed Church Hall	Budshead	The resident comments that the size of district EG should warrant a review of its boundaries. The polling station for EG, Derriford United Reformed Church Hall is a long distance to travel for electors who reside south of Looseleigh Lane. The polling station is at the top of a very long hill which makes it hard to reach for residents with reduced mobility.

07/12/2018	Mobile unit on Dunnet Road	Southway	The resident notes that the location of the mobile polling unit in Dunnet Road in district FB (situated at the bottom of a hill, near the junction between Dunnet Road and Tamerton Foliot Road) is not adequate and suggests a relocation.
14/12/2018	Widewell Primary School	Southway	This resident proposes moving the polling station for district FE in Southway ward out of Widewell Primary due to concern that the school's full closure compromises the children's attendance, and partial closure poses additional safeguarding issues. As an alternative, the resident suggests using a mobile polling station either within a fenced off area to the side of the school, or at Beverston Green.
