## **NOTICE OF ORDER HAVING BEEN MADE**

### **THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT ORDER NO. 2021.2137261 MUTLEY BARRACKS AND NAPIER TERRACE CAR PARKS) ORDER 2021**

Notice is hereby given that **PLYMOUTH CITY COUNCIL** have made the above named Order under its powers 32, 33, 35 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the 1984 Act) and all other powers enabling them in that behalf and following consultation in accordance with Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act and the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996:

**The effect of the order shall be to change the tariffs at both Napier Terrace Car Park and Mutley Barracks Car Park to ' Up to 3 hours free', 'Over 3 hours £5' and '£50 per month'.**

Subject to Schedule 9 Part VI of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions in it on the grounds that the Order is not within the relevant powers or that any of the relevant requirements or regulations made hereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, make an application for that purpose to the High Court.
