## Additional/Policy Map Modifications

Additionally, as a distinct exercise which is not a part of the JLP Public Examination process, the Councils are undertaking a separate consultation on Additional Modifications to the JLP and updated policies maps. Responses to these documents will **only be considered by the Councils** and not by the Planning Inspectors as they do not relate to the soundness of the plan.

**Please note:** For both consultations, this is not an opportunity to re-state previous representations, as these have already been considered by the Inspectors as part of the examination. This is also not an opportunity to raise new objections to the previous submission version of the JLP or to seek further changes to it.
