



NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

Referendum on the adoption of the Plympton St Mary`s Ward Neighbourhood Development Plan

1. A referendum will be held on Thursday, 2 May 2019 to decide on the question below:

Do you want Plymouth City Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Plympton St Mary to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?

2. The Referendum will be held on the same date, Thursday, 2 May 2019, as the City Council election for the Plympton St Mary's Ward.

3. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Friday, 12 April 2019. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.

4. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Ballard House, West Hoe Road, Plymouth, PL1 3BJ by 5pm on Monday, 15 April 2019.

5. New applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address by 5pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2019.

6. An elector can apply to the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address to appoint an emergency proxy up to 5pm on polling day if they

a) have had a medical emergency* after 5pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2019.

*The form must be supported by a registered medical practitioner or a registered nurse. If the elector lives at a residential home or in sheltered housing, the matron, home care director or warden may support the application

Or;

b) cannot go to the polling station due to their occupation, service or employment which they only became aware of after 5pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2019.
