Sections taken through the site to counter the incorrect assertion given at para 13 of PCC's proof that there is no direct line of sight between the monitoring equipment used in Ian Sharland's report and the haul road within the boundary of the quarry.

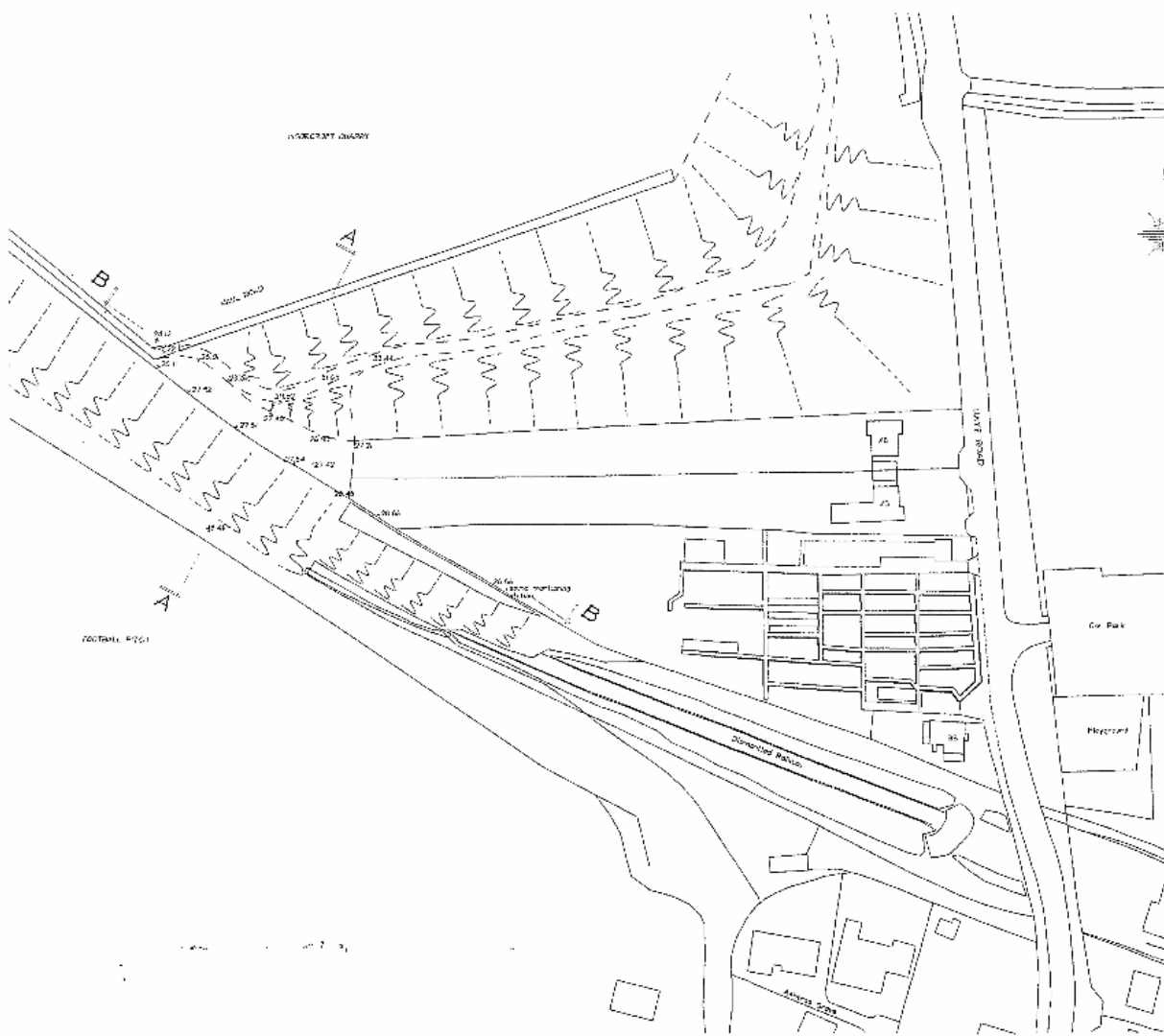
The sections show that there is an existing direct line of sight, the conclusion being that the HQPT will make minimal difference.

The Council's assertion was that there is no direct line of sight, therefore the noise impact statement is an irrelevant consideration for when the HQPT breaches the existing noise attenuation bund.

Noise associated with the HQPT itself is a separate matter. This is a small matter, but one that we wished to respond to nonetheless.
