Plymouth City Council is carrying out a review of the polling districts and polling places in the city. This is required under section 18C of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

The consultation period commences on Monday 5 November 2018, for a period of six weeks.

All comments must be received by Friday 14 December 2018. In accordance with the Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006, any correspondence will be published on our website on completion of the review.

We welcome views on any aspect of polling districts, polling places or polling stations currently used and invite any interested body, political group or registered elector within Plymouth to take part.
