

# Parks and Waterfront **BBQ** Guidelines

Our Parks and Waterfront areas are spectacular places to visit and we need your help to keep them beautiful, especially if you plan on a BBQ. Please follow these guidelines.

## **BBQ safely:**

- Use charcoals. Gas BBQs are not allowed.
- Only use approved BBQ fuel or firelighters. Never use petrol, paraffin or biofuel.
- Put your BBQ on level ground away from trees, houses, park furniture and other people.
- Protect the grass from getting scorched by raising BBQs off the ground.
- Take some water to put it out and make sure it's cool before moving it.
- Empty cooled charcoal and ash into BBQ bin if provided or take it home with you.
- Keep children, pets, games and sports well away from the cooking area.
- Never leave the BBQ unattended.

## **BBQ responsibly:**

- Use designated BBQ areas only if they are defined.
- Please don't play loud music, think of others.
- Please recycle where possible and place litter in bins or take home. Littering can result in a fine.



We will be monitoring the success of these guidelines to make sure people can BBQ without causing damage or nuisance. If there is BBQ misuse in these special places we will have to put a ban in place.
